MAP AIMED TO HAVE ITS FUTURE SUPERSTARS

In pursuit to continue instilling the talent and discipline at an early stage through arts and culture, on Thursday the 30th August 2018 Maluti A Phofung Local Municipality (MAP) held a Municipal Crèche Competition in Sediba Community Hall in Tshieme.

Several Day Care Centres in Tshieme and surrounding areas came out in numbers to take part in the Competition at the hall, where the competition initiated by MAP Sports, Arts, Culture and Recreation Directorate in advocacy of early childhood learning as being the key and proper foundation in children's academic education. MAP Arts and Culture officer, Lebohang Mothibedi explains "our aim is to unlock children's talent and for developing and guiding them through sports.
